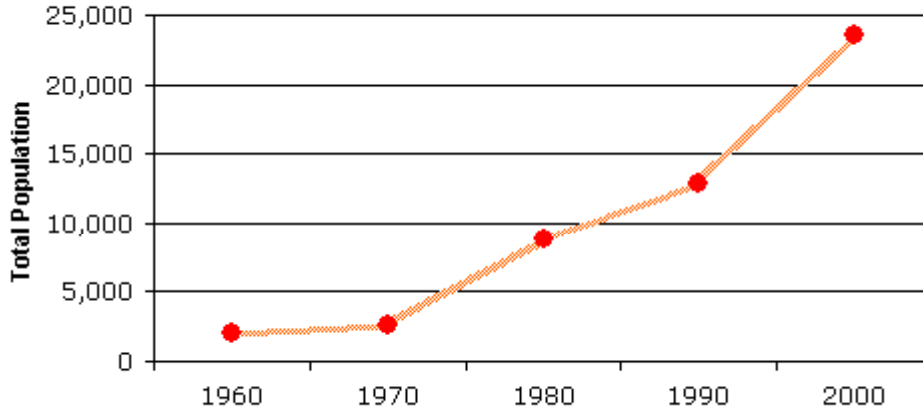

Population, 1960-2000



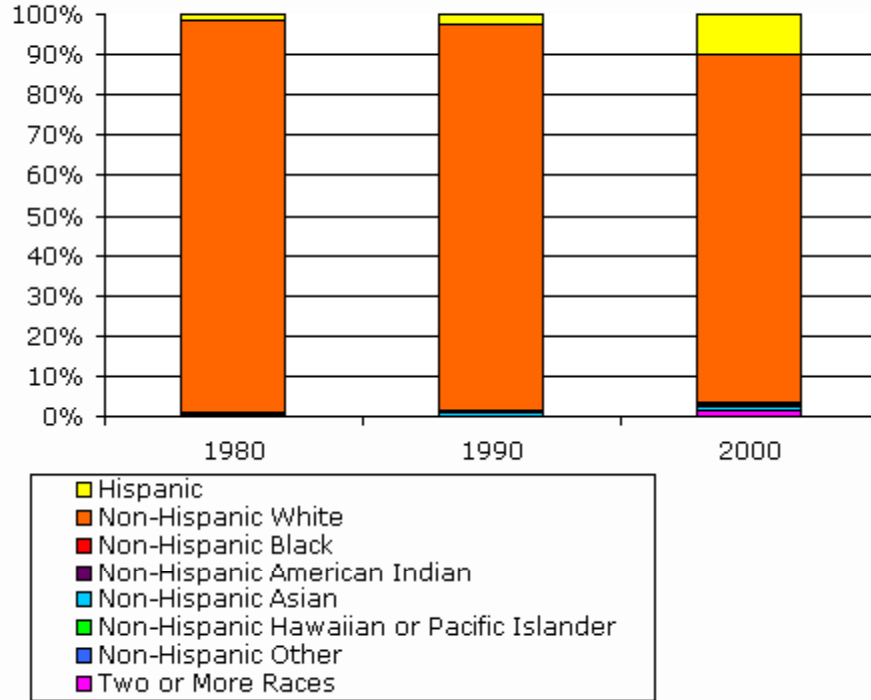

Hispanic Population and Race Distribution for Non-Hispanic Population

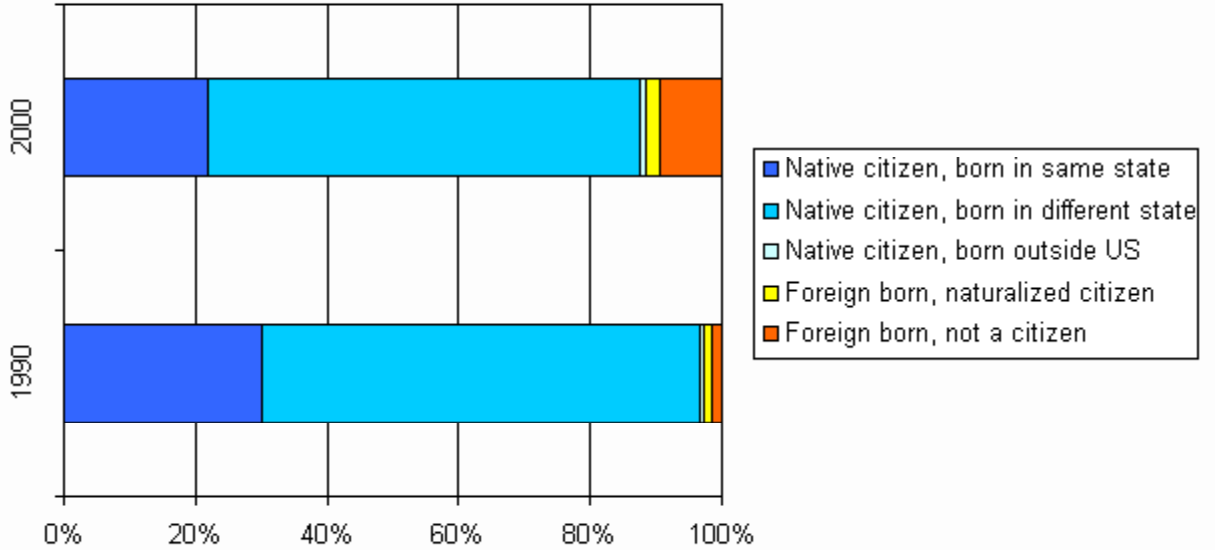

Nativity & Citizenship, 1990-2000



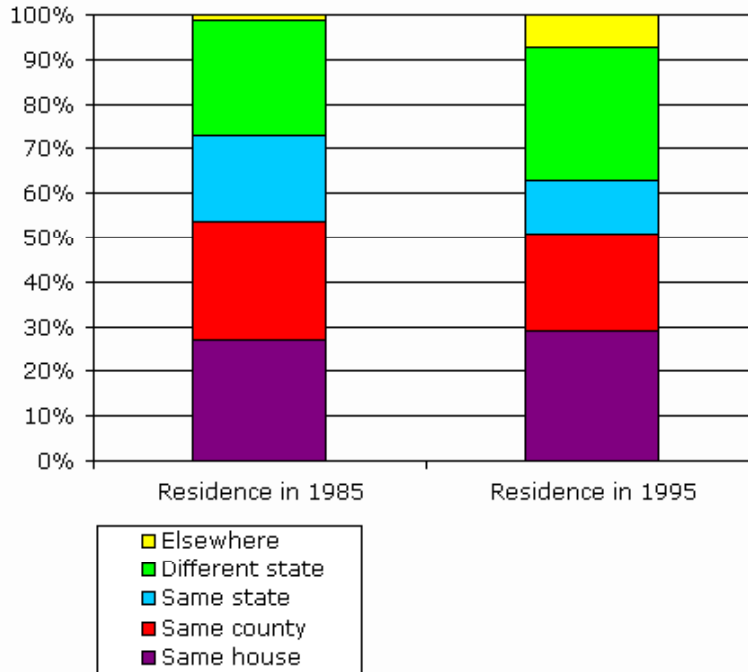

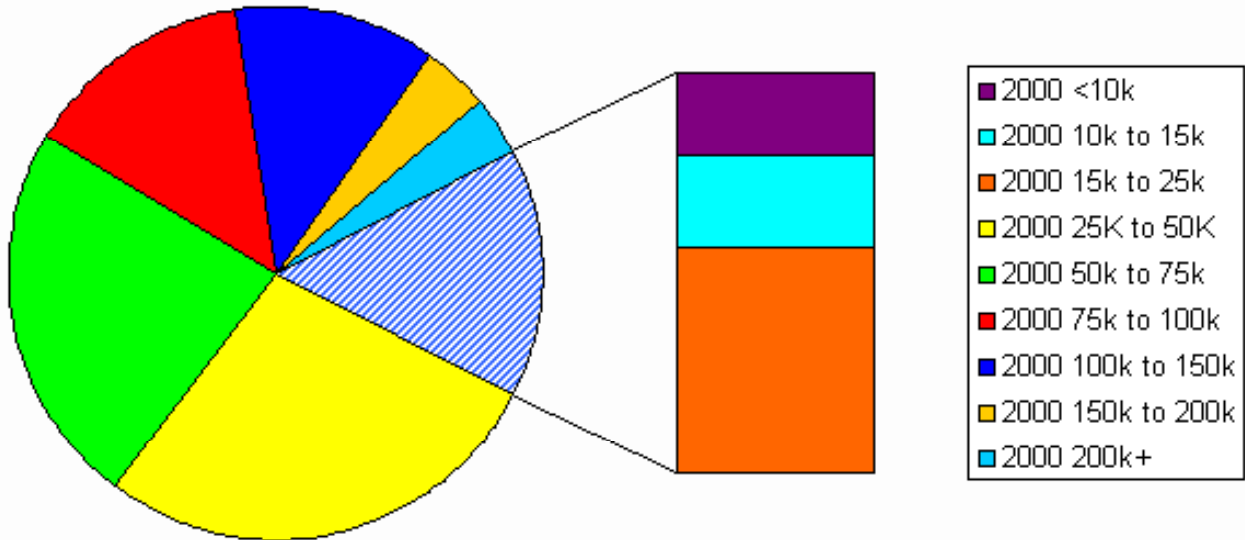

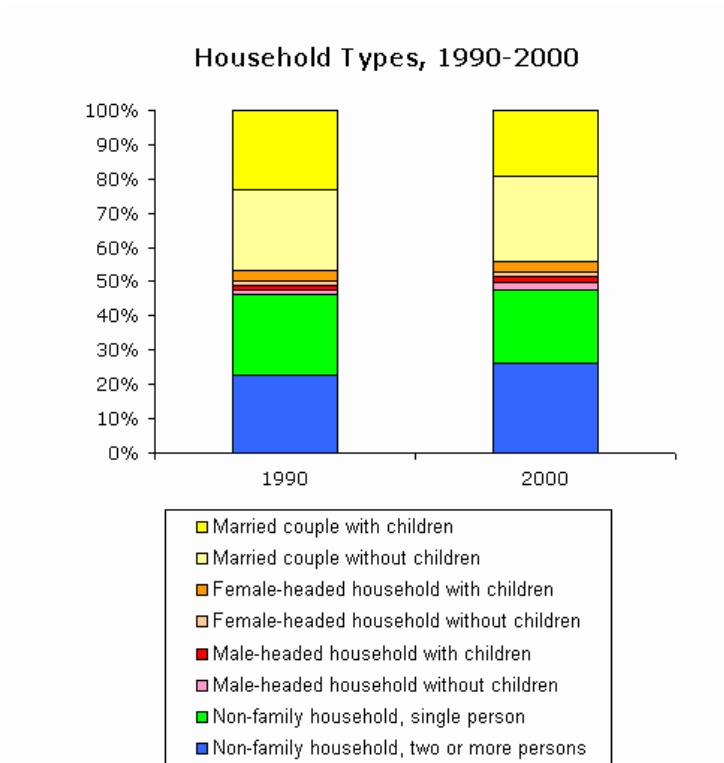

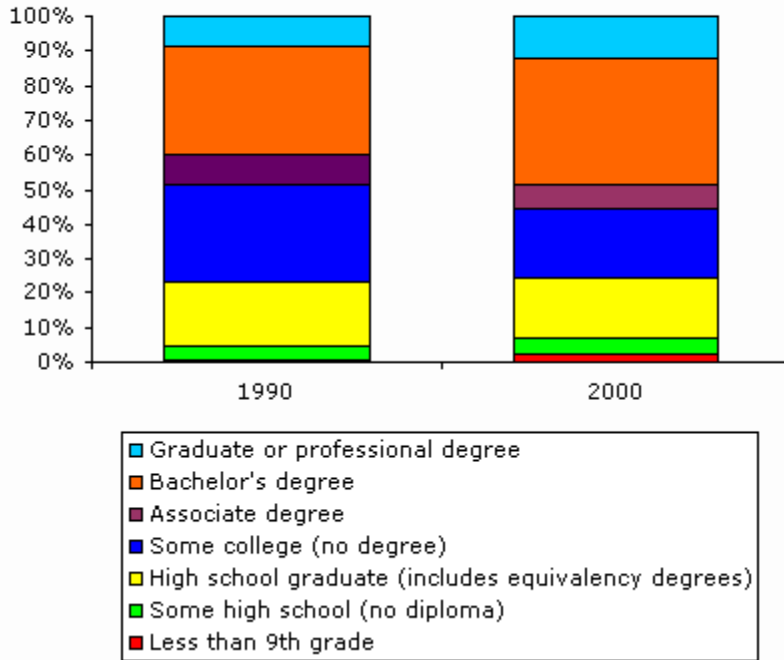

Educational Attainment, 1990-2000



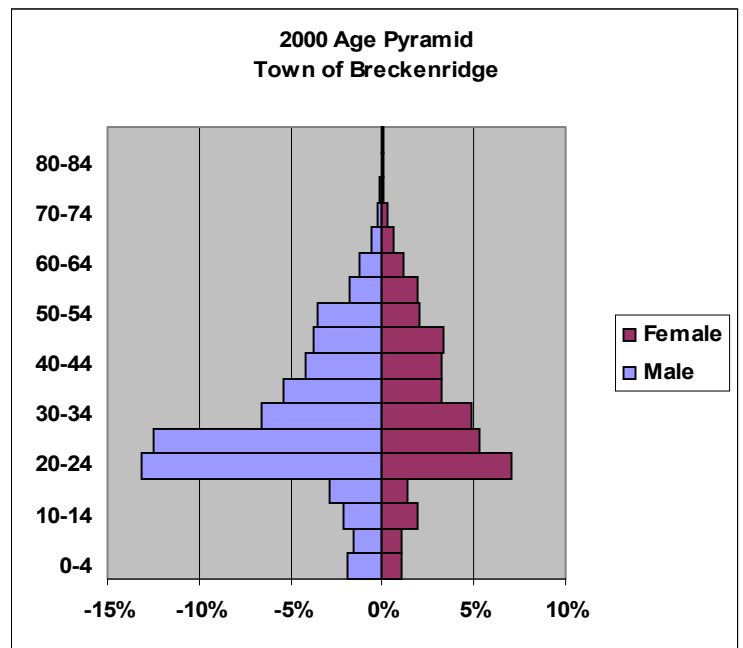
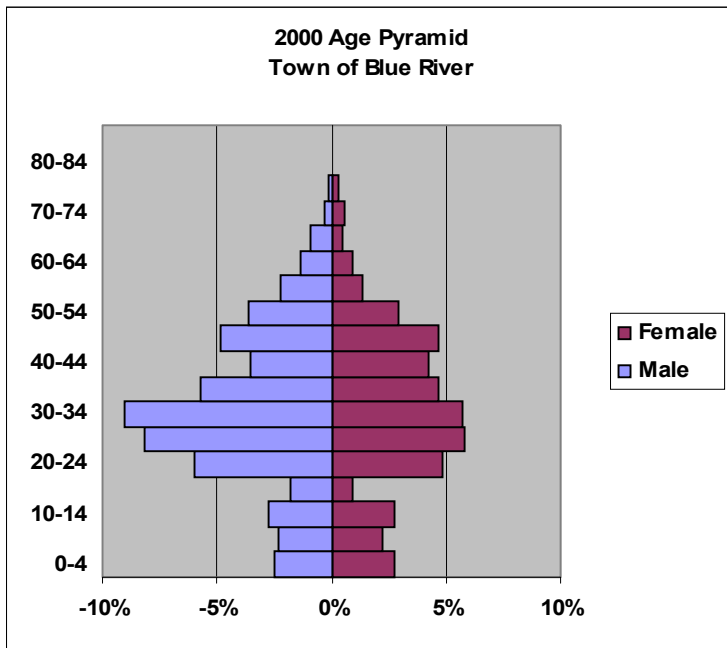
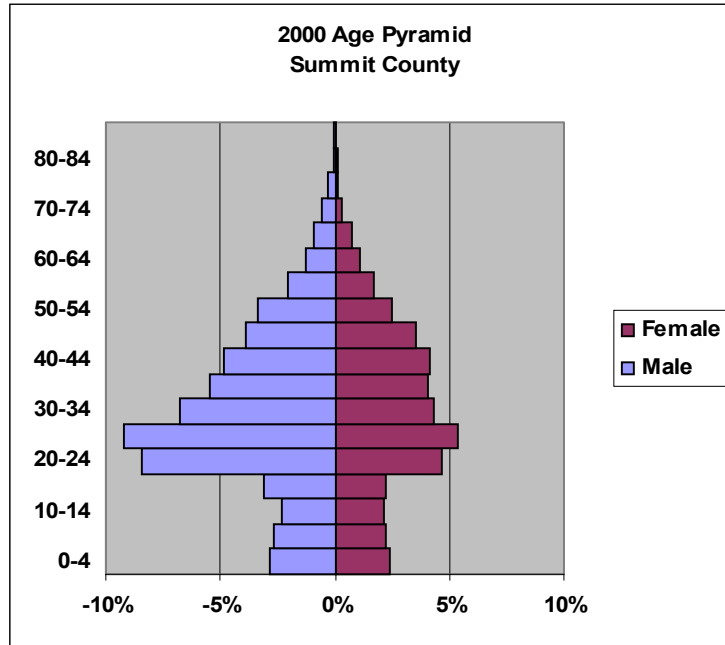
